Let Us Dwell in Love

(1 John 4:16)

Introduction:

- 1. According to 1 John 4:16, "God is love."
- 2. This morning we covered 3 things that God does for His children because He is love.
- 3. This verse also shows that God's children are to dwell in love.
- 4. Those who dwell in love are blessed in that:
 - a. they dwell in God
 - b. God dwells in them.
- 5. In our lesson we are examining passages that teach us what we need to know about dwelling in love.
- 6. Let us begin by pointing out that . . .

Discussion:

- I. WE ARE NOT TO DWELL IN CERTAIN TYPES OF LOVE
 - A. (John 12:42-43) We must not love "the praise of men more than the praise of God."
 - 1. This problem prevented the Pharisees from confessing the Lord.
 - 2. If we want Jesus to confess us we must confess Him (Matthew 10:32-33).
 - B. (I Timothy 6:10) We must not love "money."
 - 1. The love of money:
 - a. prevented the rich young ruler from following Jesus (Matthew 19:16-22)
 - b. caused the first scandal in the church (Acts 5:1-11).
 - 2. In I Timothy 6:17-19, Paul showed us what God wants.
 - C. (II Timothy 3:1-2a) We must not love ourselves in the sense of thinking too highly of ourselves (Romans 12:3).
 - D. (II Timothy 3:4) We must not be "lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God."
 - E. (I John 2:15-17) We must not love "the world."
 - F. (III John 9) We must not love having "preeminence."
- II. WE ARE TO DWELL IN CERTAIN TYPES OF LOVE
 - A. We are to love God (Matthew 22:37; I John 5:3).
 - B. We are to love Christ (Matthew 10:37; John 14:15).
 - C. We are to love our neighbors (Matthew 22:39; 7:12).
 - D. We are to love our fellow Christians (John 13:34-35).
 - E. We are to love God's Word (Psalm 119:97).
 - F. We are to love the lost (Romans 10:1).

Conclusion:

- 1. In I Corinthians 13:13 the Bible shows us how important love is.
- 2. Love is so important that we are to dwell in it.
- 3. Those who dwell in love are assured that:
 - a. they dwell in God
 - b. God dwells in them.
