People that Obeyed the Lord

(Mark 16:15-16)

Introduction:

- 1. In Mark 16:15-16 the Lord's Great Commission is recorded.
 - a. Jesus told the apostles to preach the Gospel to everyone (vs.15).
 - b. He also told them what to preach so people could be saved (vs.16).
- 2. We learn from Mark 16:19-20 that the Lord ascended and the apostles followed His instructions.
- 3. The Lord gave the apostles a plan for carrying out His mission (Acts 1:8).
- 4. The book of Acts shows how the apostles followed this plan and reached many people with the Gospel.
- 5. In this lesson we are looking at a number of "people that obeyed the Lord" as a result of learning the Gospel.
