Introduction:

2. They made 2 special blessings available -- "redemption" and "adoption."
3. Jesus fulfilled God's promise when He came.
4. This evening we are covering verses that reveal "why Jesus came to earth."

Discussion:

I. LET US EXAMINE THE GOSPEL OF MATTHEW

- A. (Matthew 5:17-18) Jesus came to fulfill the law and the prophets.
- B. (Matthew 9:13) He came to call sinners to repentance.

II. LET US EXAMINE THE GOSPEL OF MARK

- A. (Mark 1:35-39) Jesus came to preach.
- B. (Mark 10:45) He came to minister and to give His life as a ransom for many.

III. LET US EXAMINE THE GOSPEL OF LUKE

- A. (Luke 4:16-21) Jesus came to accomplish important objectives.
- B. (Luke 19:10) He came to seek and to save the lost.

IV. LET US EXAMINE THE GOSPEL OF JOHN

- A. (John 6:38) Jesus came to do the Father's will (John 4:34).
- B. (John 10:10) He came so we might have life and have it more abundantly.

V. LET US EXAMINE THE BOOK OF HEBREWS

- A. (Hebrews 2:16-18) Jesus came to be tempted so He could be our High Priest.
- B. (Hebrews 4:14-16) He is able to empathize with us because He faced all the temptations that we face.
